GENERAL BUSINESS:

- Leanne introduced Mark Pillar, President of the Allora Show Society who then gave us an overview of what's happening there. Many changes would like to be implemented over the next few years including moving the cattle from beside our poultry pavilion & have it made into another section for the waterfowl, thus giving us more pens enabling us to maybe hire our pavilion out to other clubs that require more room than we currently have & giving us the opportunity to operate the canteen on those days. Toowoomba Show Grounds currently charge the sum of \$350.00 per poultry show.
- Keith & Daryl have cleaned out the pens, so much easier than having to do them when everything has dried.
- We need to get all other boards etc. onto the walls before the next show.
- The Honour Board is to be updated.

- Keith suggested that we add Heavy & Light Breeds to the Soft Feather section of our shows, all in agreement.
- Craig suggested that we have a Twilight Show 3pm –7pm for the Ag. Show in February next year as a way of combating the heat stress on the birds. He also suggested having incubators there for people & kids to see the chickens hatching, all in agreement.
- Keryn suggested that we may have some backyard chooks to sell
- Warren Young passed over another \$260.00 from proceeds from the Footy Doubles
- We will purchase \$20.00 worth of tickets in the Junior Poultry Judges Raffle. Keryn to organize and do this.
- We need to purchase a sensory light for outside the door, & purchase a spotlight for the Champion Cages.
- Our next Government Grant application would be for a cement floor in the old pavilion, new LED lighting so we can run twilight shows, a roller door for the external shed doorway, ceiling insulation & a Solar Whizz for removing hot air. Keryn to work on this.
